I thank all of you on behalf of the Jawahar family for your appreciation and support to my community kitchen - Swabhiman Bhoj.

The Swabhiman Bhoj program successfully served over 62,000 meals to date and is now in three cities: Ajmer, Bhilwara and Banswara. Currently, it is serving close to 30,000 meals every month. The foundation is creating a long-term impact on society by providing a reliable source of food to the needy. People living below the poverty line now do not have to worry about hunger while raising a family. Since a huge percentage of the visitors are children below 18 years of age, we feel proud to be able to help these kids become healthier as they focus on their education and careers. Going strong with my vision, I aim to open more branches of the Swabhiman Bhoj program in Rajasthan in the near future.

The foundation has been scaling its work to upgrade the overall quality of life of the regional people. We organised a medical camp in Bhilwara providing free health checkups to the people. We also organised a tree plantation drive in Ajmer and sanitized several areas of the city to prevent the mass spread of Coronavirus.

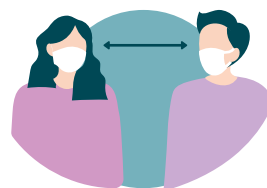

### 75 CORONA WARRIORS FELICITATED AT R.V.R.S. MEDICAL COLLEGE



As the fight against COVID continues, a number of people still work behind the scenes to ensure that the rest of us feel safe stepping out and meeting people. These silent warriors need to be acclaimed for their selfless work in tough times.

Jawahar Foundation's program 'We Salute Corona Warriors' honours the heroes of the pandemic. One such heroic example was set by the medical students of Rajmata Vijaya Raje Scindia Medical College, Bhilwara. The college trained the students and prepped the microbiology department in a short while for the anticipated mass testing requirement as COVID cases began to rise in 2020. The strong willpower of

the students and the staff supported by impeccable team management skills helped make the 'Bhilwara Model' a success.

This model was an aggressive measure by the Rajasthan government to curb the cases in Bhilwara as the city became one of the earliest hotspots of COVID cases in the country.

75 students and staff of the medical college were felicitated by the chief guest- former DCP Anil Dangi in the presence of Jawahar Foundation's OSD Rajnish Verma and microbiology department head Ms Varsha. The event was presided over by the college principal Dr Pawan Sharma.

## HEALTH CAMP ORGANISED IN BHILWARA



A medical health checkup camp was organised at the Bhilwara branch of Swabhiman Bhoj in Gajadhar Mansinghka Dharamshala in association with Bhilwara City Lions Club and Mahatma Gandhi Hospital under the Rajasthan Mukhyamantri Nishulk Janch Yojana. This scheme was started in 2013 to provide quality essential diagnostic services in all government health care institutions and contribute to the fundamental

Right to Health. The camp tested the visitors' blood pressure, blood sugar, DLC, TLC, haemoglobin, etc.

SDM Om Prabha inspected the operations and appreciated the initiative by calling out other social service organisations to come forward and plan such camps frequently so the city residents can timely receive curative health care.

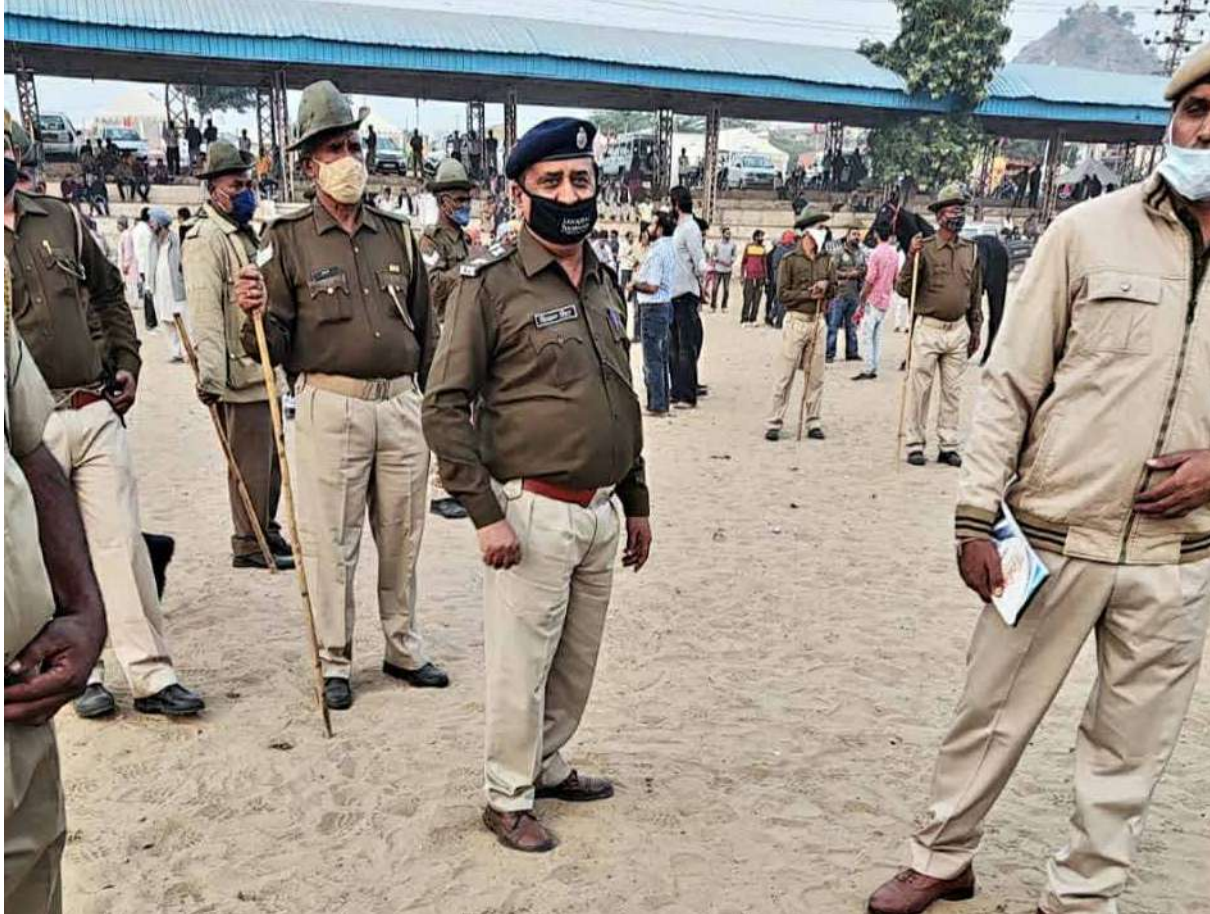
