The Swabhiman Bhoj program, which started with its first centre in Bhilwara, has been successfully expanded to two more locations in Rajasthan. On 13th October, we inaugurated these new branches in Ajmer and Banswara and with this we are now serving 30,000+ meals in Rajasthan every month.

Since, a huge percentage of the visitors are children below 18 years of age, we feel proud to be able to help these kids become healthier as they focus on their education and careers. To further support education through our food security initiatives, we regularly distributed eatables amongst REET and other government exam participants in Ajmer. Going strong with my vision, I aim to open more branches of the Swabhiman Bhoj program in Rajasthan, in near future.

Operating in a diligent, organised manner, the foundation has been scaling its work to upgrade the overall quality of life of the regional people. My aim is to provide education, access to food, and healthcare to those living in the extremities right now.

Food Security

Food security is the fundamental right of every living being. The Jawahar Foundation strives to provide meals to the hungry and the needy in Re 1. It endeavours to serve quality food and nourishment through various city-wide campaigns and community kitchens.



Education

Education is key to a growing society. In order to further the development of Ajmer and Bhilwara, robust measures to ensure continued education for students are much needed. The foundation hopes to financially support young dreams and encourage pursuing higher education. For this, scholarship schemes will be introduced to promote academics as well as sports.

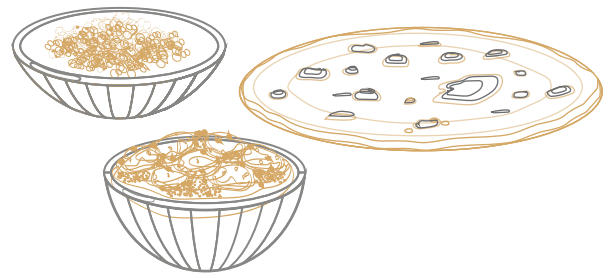

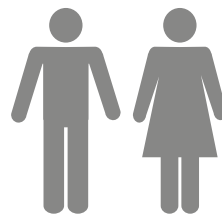

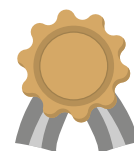

The Jail Training Institute (JTI) in Ajmer was in need of a toilet complex in its huge training grounds. This ground is heavily used for training practices, events, and parades. However, the lack of a proper toilet facility became a point of discomfort which was brought to Mr Riju Jhunjunwala's notice during a tree

plantation drive at the complex sometime ago.

Soon after the city-wise lockdowns eased out, the foundation started on the construction work for this complex. On Oct 13th, the building was inaugurated by Mr Lalji Desai and Mr Riju Jhunjunwala.

Swabhimani Bhoj Opens in Ajmer and Banswara on Oct 13th



Jawahar Foundation has been constantly and aggressively working to aid food security in Rajasthan. With the vision of opening several Swabhimani Bhoj branches across the state, the foundation's founder, Mr Riju Jhunjunwala started two new branches of its popular Swabhimani Bhoj program, in the cities of Ajmer and Banswara.

Swabhimani Bhoj program is a chain

of community kitchens serving nutritious meals at a nominal Re 1 to everyone.

Mr Lalji Desai, National President, All India Congress Sewa Dal, along with Mr Jhunjunwala, inaugurated the Ajmer branch located in Dua market, Alwar Gate, Ajmer.

The event was attended by more than 1,200 people; all of them had lunch at



the bhojanalaya.

Swabhiman Bhoj, Banswara was inaugurated by MLA Shri Arjun Singh Bamaniya on the same day. The event attracted 400 locals who were addressed by the regional leaders and Mr Bamaniya himself.

Now operational in three cities – Ajmer, Banswara, and Bhilwara, the program is serving 30,000+ people per month in the state.

Two years ago, Jawahar Foundation had sponsored the plantation of 300 saplings each of rose and amla in Women Central Jail, Ajmer. These saplings have grown to together form a beautiful garden in the women jail area. Marking the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, Jawahar Foundation

renamed this garden as the Ba-Bapu Vatika after Gandhi ji and his wife, Kasturba Gandhi Ji. Our founder, Riju Jhunjhunwala planted a small sapling to mark the occasion.

During the COVID times, the foundation planted over 20k trees in and around Ajmer.

Tribute Paid to Gandhian and Freedom Fighter- Subba Rao



Dr S.N. Subba Rao was a freedom fighter and a Gandhian who played a vital role in the surrender of 400 bandits and 100 in Dholpur in the 1970s. He passed away on 27th October, 2021 after his health suddenly deteriorated overnight.

Our founder, Riju Jhunjhunwala, along with several other members of the

foundation paid tribute to Rao on his sudden demise.

Dr Rao was associated with the first Prime Minister Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru on several projects related to non-violence. He was also instrumental in forming the peace and non-violence cell.
