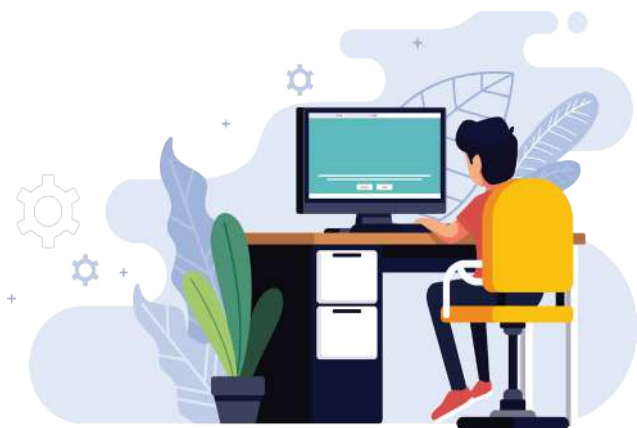

## Swabhiman Bhoj: Looking Back at the Year



Swabhiman Bhoj touched new highs by the end of the year with people embracing our centres in Ajmer, Banswara, and Bhilwara. Within just 5 months of operations, Swabhiman Bhoj has successfully served 99,000+ meals.

Adapting to the regional preferences, these community kitchens serve foods ranging from a nutritious preparation of lentils with rice to serving seasonal vegetables, along with chapati, rice, and salad. On festivals and special occasions, these meals are perked with an addition of something sweet on the side. We actually opened





the Banswara and Ajmer centres exactly two months after inaugurating the Bhilwara kitchen on 16th August 2021.

This location still remains one of the most special ones for the significance it carries. To date, it is also the centre that attracts the most crowd since it carries the crown of being the first one in the series.

Today, we are serving freshly cooked meals to school kids, labourers, small shop owners, unemployed, and the old and needy. With such diverse crowd flowing in to the centres daily, our vision of creating a dining space that speaks of equality has been realised.
