I am extremely elated to announce that in the coming months, we will be setting new milestones in the areas of food security and providing clean drinking water in Rajasthan.

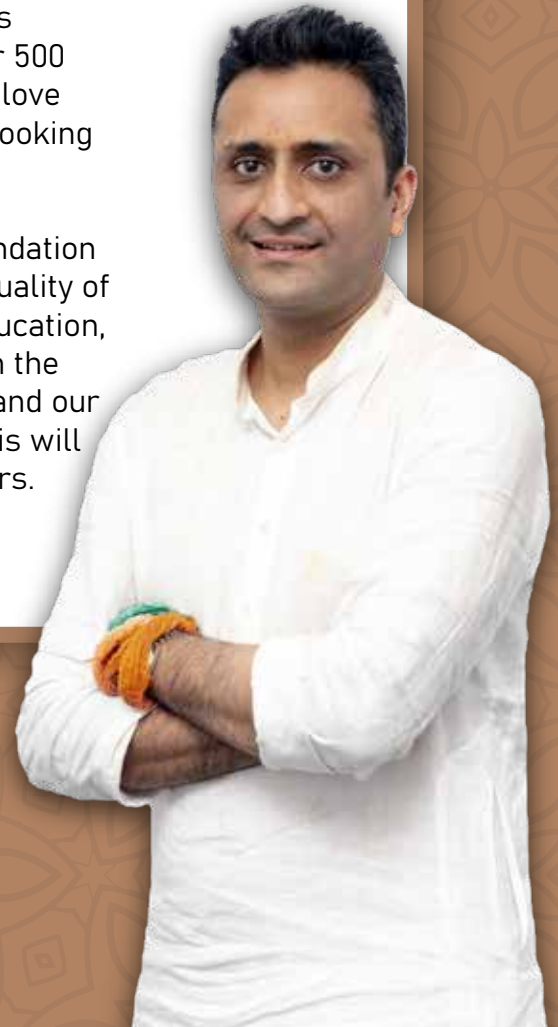
We have launched the Swabhiman Bhoj in Jaipur now! The centre has opened on 4th May 2022 in Jhotwara, Hathoj and is now operational. In our upcoming issue, we'll tell you more about this new centre, which has quickly become a popular destination for the general public, with over 400 people visiting every day.

Simultaneously, our constant efforts in setting up systems to provide clean water in remote areas of the state has also bore fruit and we will be launching a brand new water project in the month of May, itself.

We met several dignitaries this month opening opportunities for conversations on the Swabhiman Bhoj program and raised awareness around the same. What give me constant motivation is the recognition received for our three Swabhiman Bhoj centres in Ajmer, Banswara, and Bhilwara.

Mahatma Jyotiba Phule and Savitri Bai's Statues to be Installed in Ganahera, Pushkar



Riju Jhunjhunwala, founder of Jawahar Foundation will be providing financial aid to install the statues of the changemaker Jyoti Rao Phule and his wife, India's first female teacher and headmistress, Savitribai at the Ganahera crossing in Pushkar. The duo was engaged in a passionate struggle to build a movement for equality between men and women and a fight against the caste system.

They started the first school in the country for girls and the 'Native Library'. In 1863, they started a 'home for the prevention of infanticide' in their own house, to ensure the safety of pregnant and exploited widows. They also established the Satyashodhak Samaj (Society for Truth Seeking), initiating the practice of marriage without dowry or overt expenses. This is an initiative by Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Rashtriya Jagriti Manch.
